

Supply List 2017-18 - Grade 7

Dear Parents of a 7th grader,

To make shopping for school supplies a little easier for you this year we have created our supply list early. We ask that you do **NOT** buy trapper keepers as these do **NOT** fit into the lockers. Your 7th grader will need the following supplies in September:

- A 3-ring binder for Social (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " fit best in the lockers)
- A 3-ring binder for Science (2 inch)
- A 3-ring binder for Technology (1")
- A 3-ring binder for ELA (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ")
- A 3-ring binder for Math (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ")
- A 3-ring binder for Math 7 Honors (2")
- 1-Composition notebook for ELA
- 1-Composition notebook for Science
- 1-subject notebook for **Math 7 AIS**
- (4)** 2-pocket folders
- (5)** Zipper Pouch for each binder, if possible, that will hold pencils, cap erasers, calculator, post-it notes, etc...
- One package of dividers with tabs
- One package of plastic page protectors for Science and ELA
- Pens (red and blue or black) and pencils (and extra lead for mechanical pencils)
- Colored pencils for Science, ELA, and Technology
- Dry-erase markers
- Highlighters
- Loose leaf paper
- Scientific Calculator with an Ab/c button (specifically CASIO fx-260solar or any Casio calculator that has the Ab/c button) for Math 7.
- Index cards for flashcards for Science (2 packs of 100) and ELA
- Gluesticks
- Scissors

Art (Mr. Hubbard):

- 1 dozen pencils (Ticonderoga work the best) Students will not use pens in the Art room.
- 2-3 Black Sharpie Markers - Fine Point
- Container to hold art supplies
- 2 glue sticks

Health (Mr. Peterson):

- One Pocket Folder
- Loose Leaf Paper
- Pencils and Pens

PE:

- T-shirt and sweatshirt, sweatpants, shorts or/and windpants
- Sneakers
- Deodorant

Technology (Mr. Dupree):

- 1" 3-ring binder
- 3 Dividers and Lined paper
- Lots of pencils (Students will not use pen in the Technology Lab)
- Zipper Pouch for binder that will hold pencils and erasers
- Ruler (That can measure 1/16")
